TIME ZONE:

London is 1 hour behind Spain.

ELECTRICITY:

Local supply is 220/240 volt AC 50 cycle. Two round pin plugs are in general use - an adapter for English/American plug

is necessary.

WATER:

Tap water on Base comes from a natural Spring and is excellent. Anywhere else the water is safe but might not taste as well so you will probably find it best to drink

mineral water.

WEATHER:

We expect very hot sunny weather. The location can get extremely hot during the day (up & over 30o to 40o C) so please bring appropriate head gear and sun protection creams.

DRIVING:

Before you can drive a car provided by the Company you must be over 23, have a full License and a photocopy of your license.

- * BEFORE YOU DRIVE A COMPANY CAR. THE TRANSPORT OFFICE MUST HAVE A COPY OF YOUR LICENSE.

UNIT CARS AND MINIBUSES

- * THESE ARE FOR ARTISTS AND CREW TO GET TO WORK AT HOME. THEY ARE NOT FOR FAMILY AND FRIENDS (SINCE THEY ARE NOT INSURED TO RIDE IN COMPANY VEHICLES.)
- * SELF-DRIVE CARS SUPPLIED BY THE COMPANY ARE FOR DEPARTMENT USE.
- * PARKING: WILL EVERYONE PARK OUTSIDE THE GATE OF THE SITE.

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES:

WE CANNOT USE OUR DRIVERS FOR TAKING FAMILY AND FRIENDS TO OR FROM THE AIRPORT.

INSURANCE: ONLY PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THIS COMPANY ARE ALLOWED TO DRIVE THE VEHICLES (PROVIDED A PHOTOCOPY OF THEIR LICENSE HAS HANDED IN TO THE OFFICE). NO FAMILY OR FRIENDS ARE INSURED FOR THE COMPANY VEHICLE.

HEALTH CARE IS AVAILABLE IN SPAIN FOR EEC NATIONALS AS FOLLOWS:-

AMBULATORIO

- **This is the equivalent mixture of NHS GP care and a casualty department. They also do some planned child/maternity work.
- **The one in Fuengirola is normally on 24 hour call and is very good for URGENT help. Some of the staff speak English. Medicines prescribed by their staff are cheaper than normal. They can refer you to hospital in Malaga or to see a specialist and they have 2 ambulances.
- **The patient needs form Ell1 or to be able to pay if they are not members of the Social Security System.
- **HOWEVER FOR URGENT TREATMENT they take your details AFTERWARDS, they may want your passport or another form of ID pending the correct form or requesting payment.

FORM E111 (OR EQUIVALENT)

**Prior to leaving the EEC country you should have obtained one. In Great Britain you go to the Post Office, fill in your details and send it off to the DHSS, they send it back to your home stamped. You will need several photocopies and the original.

MEDICINES

- **There is always a duty FARMACIA (chemist) open from 10.00 20.00 at least, and the guarda is displayed on a noticeboard outside all farmacias. They are on call at other times.
- **If you are worried about any medical aspect please contact me either personally or by phone so that I can sort out any worries you may have about yourself or your family. Children are very well cared for here and as I have three, one of them has usually needed 'the service' over the last three years, so I can speak both from experience and a professional view.

DOCTOR/DENTIST

**There are duty company doctors and dentists. They can be reached initially through me.

My name is Mary Shaw and I am here to help with any health related problems you may have or may be worried about. The Occupational Health Service is totally confidential. A few notes you may find of help:-

**Be aware that the sun's rays can still BURN you even when it is misty/cloudy etc. Great care is needed for fragile areas ie nose, back of neck, shoulders, hands and feet. The greatest danger hours are 12.00 to 16.00.

**You will sweat a lot until you are used to the heat (which is not the same as sunshine), it can be very humid for instance at night, therefore you need to drink extra non-alcoholic drinks. These do not need to always be bottled types, the tap water is safe and lemon or mint tea drunk warm or cold (not iced) is very refreshing. Should you feel thirsty and drink either very rapidly or ice cold drinks this will do you no good at all. So sip your drink to alleviate the problems.


**Protect your head and back of your neck by wearing a wide brimmed hat (or suitable cap back to front). Wear a tee-shirt and trainers to protect other body areas and use a high factor protection cream for exposed areas and gradually reduce the factor number.

**Dust can be a problem (not only for people who wear contact lenses) but for both eyes, skin, and sinus cavities. If you think this may be a serious problem for you (ie you have suffered from asthma, hayfever or other allery talk to me BEFORE you have a problem because each person is different).

**Chemists will often give you medicines that really need a doctors' prescription. Please be very careful.

**I have a pager (Busc-person), dial 236 19 11 and you can speak in English (although she will initially answer in Spanish), give the number code 3771 followed by a message. I also have an answerphone at home:- 246 16 76, I prefer to be 'disturbed' anytime rather than have a larger problem to deal with later.

**Cotton wool is called ALGODON and gauze squares come in a tin called GASA. Tablets in bottles UNLESS with a special insert tend to go 'off' due to heat/humidity so most are foil wrapped.
