

WELCOME TO ELDORADO

Welcome to 'Eldorado' - a coast of golden dreams and deep, dark secrets in a sun-drenched setting, which begins on BBC-1 on Monday, July 6 1992.

The half-hour episodes are screened at 7 pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with a chance to see each one again on Wednesday and Friday at 1.50 pm and Sunday at 3 pm.

Created by Tony Holland from an idea by John Dark and Verity Lambert, and produced by Julia Smith, 'Eldorado' follows the fortunes of a community of ex-patriots living in southern Spain.

The production, made for the BBC by leading independent Cinema Verity, is one of the most ambitious in British television history.

'Eldorado' is shot entirely on location in Spain, centred on a spectacular 25-acre production village which has been specially built in the mountains above Malaga, near Coin.
